CONSENT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT

BETWEEN:

THE COMMISSIONER, APPOINTED UNDER THE *TEACHERS ACT*  
(the "Commissioner")

AND:

DARRYL EGAN INANCSI  
("Inancsi")

**BACKGROUND and FACTS**

1. Inancsi held a Standard Certificate of Qualification, No. ██████████. It was issued by the B.C. College of Teachers (the "College") under the *Teaching Profession Act* on December 15, 1994, and was valid from September 1, 1994. Inancsi currently holds a valid Professional Certificate of Qualification, No. ██████████. It was issued by the College under the *Teaching Profession Act* on October 28, 1997, is valid from September 1, 1997, and continued under the *Teachers Act* as of January 9, 2012.
2. At all material times, Inancsi was employed as a high school teacher by School District No.78 (Fraser-Cascade) (the "District") at a District school (the "School").
3. On October 29, 2012, the District made a report to the Commissioner regarding Inancsi, under section 16 of the *School Act*.
4. The following events occurred in September 2012 when Inancsi was teaching at the School, he interacted with students in an inappropriate and unprofessional way when: ██████████

- a. During class, he asked a female grade 11 student who was pregnant if her pregnancy made her “hornier”.
  - b. He asked another female student whether she did drugs over the summer.
  - c. During class, he told a male grade eight student to “pick up your shit and get the hell out of here.”
  - d. When the School principal came to investigate raised voices she heard coming from Inancsi’s classroom, Inancsi told her more than once, in the presence of the class, that a student had told him to “go f\*\*k” himself.
  - e. He repeatedly raised his voice and swore at students.
5. On October 25, 2012, the District issued Inancsi a letter of discipline. As part of that letter of discipline, Inancsi was directed to take part in counseling, including anger management counseling through the Employee Family Assistance Program. He was also required to complete the BCTF’s professional boundaries course before June 30, 2013.
  6. Inancsi completed the BCTF boundaries course on January 24, 2013. He also attended three counselling sessions after he was issued the letter of discipline on October 25, 2012.
  7. Inancsi was previously disciplined by the District in respect of inappropriate and unprofessional interactions with students as follows: letters of reprimand on December 1, 2001 and March 12, 2001, and letters of direction on February 15, 2008, and September 29, 2008.
  8. Inancsi has not been teaching since September 2013 when he commenced a leave of absence.
  9. On September 26, 2017, the Commissioner considered this matter and determined to propose a consent resolution agreement to Inancsi, in accordance with section 53(1)(a) of the *Teachers Act*.

## **DISPOSITION**

10. This Agreement is made under section 53 of the *Teachers Act*.
11. Inancsi understands and acknowledges that this Agreement is not effective until executed by the Commissioner, and that the date of execution by the Commissioner will be the effective date of this Agreement (the “Effective Date”).

12. Inancsi admits that the facts set out in paragraphs 1 to 8 of this Agreement are true.
13. Inancsi admits that the conduct described in paragraph 4 of this Agreement constitutes professional misconduct and is contrary to Standard #1 of the *Standards for the Education, Competence and Professional Conduct of Educators in British Columbia*, Fourth Edition, January 2012.
14. Inancsi agrees to a reprimand under sections 53 and 64(a) of the *Teachers Act*. The reprimand will take effect on the first business day following the Effective Date.
15. Inancsi agrees not to make any statement orally or in writing which contradicts, disputes or calls into question the terms of this Agreement or the admissions made in it.

### **CONSEQUENCES OF THE AGREEMENT**

16. The Director of Certification will record the terms of this Agreement on the Teacher Regulation Branch's online registry under section 79(d) of the *Teachers Act*.
17. Inancsi acknowledges that this Agreement will be published in accordance with section 54 of the *Teachers Act*, which includes posting the Agreement, in full, on the following website: [www.bcteacherregulation.ca](http://www.bcteacherregulation.ca).
18. A breach by Inancsi of any term in this Agreement may constitute professional misconduct which may be the subject of separate discipline proceedings.
19. Inancsi acknowledges and understands that if the Commissioner has reason to believe that he has breached any term of this Agreement:
  - a. the Commissioner may initiate an investigation under section 47(1)(b) of the *Teachers Act* into his conduct; and
  - b. the conduct and matters described in the "Background and Facts" to this Agreement are admissible in that inquiry as proof that Inancsi has admitted to the conduct and matters set out in this Agreement.


